In PE, we are learning how to improve or swimming and netball skills.

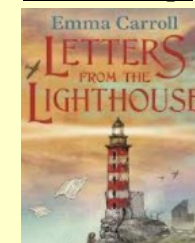
In Science, we are learning about light, dark and shadows.
