Whistleblowing procedure

If any Brooke Weston Trust employee has a complaint or concern that isn't able to be dealt with formally or at a school level then they need to put the complaint in writing and a formal process of investigation will begin.

Whistleblowing does not cover personal grievances but complaints that are in the public interest.

Examples include:

- **A criminal offence**
- **That somebody's health is in danger**
- **Damage to the environment**
- **If the organisation is breaking the law or if you believe someone is covering up a wrongdoing**
